LICENSING CONDITIONS FOR LICENCE TO REMOVE EXPLOSIVES FOR BLASTING WORK

- 1. The removal of explosives is only for the purpose of carrying out blasting work approved by the Licensing Officer.
- 2. Auxiliary Police Officers shall be engaged to escort the explosives from storage site to blasting site.
- 3. There shall be no overnight storage of the explosives at the blasting site, unless otherwise approved by the Licensing Officer.
- 4. There shall be no detour between the journeys between the storage site and blasting site.
- 5. The licensee is required to comply with all the conditions stipulated in Annexes "A" and "B" as issued together with the blasting approval and the conditions laid down by other relevant authorities.
- 6. The conveyance of explosives must be carried out in compliance to the Arms and Explosives (Explosives) Regulations.
- 7. The licensee shall immediately notify the Police if there is any:
 - (a) loss of any explosive;
 - (b) unauthorised person attempting to take part in any transportation of explosive; or
 - (c) security or safety related incident.

LICENSING CONDITIONS FOR LICENCE TO REMOVE EXPLOSIVES FOR PYROTECHNIC EFFECTS

- 1. The removal of explosives is only for the purpose of carrying out pyrotechnics display approved by the Licensing Officer.
- 2. Auxiliary Police Officers shall be engaged to escort the explosives from storage site to blasting site.
- 3. There shall be no overnight storage of the explosives at the fireworks display site, unless otherwise approved by the Licensing Officer.
- 4. There shall be no detour between the journeys between the storage site and the fireworks display site.
- 5. The licensee is required to comply with all the requirements and conditions stipulated in the Dangerous Fireworks Exemption Notification 2018.
- 6. The conveyance of explosives must be carried out in compliance to the Arms and Explosives (Explosives) Regulations.
- 7. The licensee shall immediately notify the Police if there is any:
 - (a) loss of any explosive;
 - (b) unauthorised person attempting to take part in any transportation of explosive; or
 - (c) security or safety related incident.
